SERVICES PROVIDED DURING

ONE WEEK IN KANSAS

On September 11-17, 2017, the Kansas Coalition Against Sexual and Domestic Violence (KCSDV) coordinated the third statewide census of the number and type of sexual violence services provided in one week in Kansas. 100 percent of the 27 community-based, victim advocacy programs reported. These numbers represent a snapshot of sexual violence services provided during the week. Numbers can vary week to week.

ONE VICTIM RECEIVED HELP EVERY 19 MINUTES



1,595 people were educated on sexual violence in **83** community awareness, prevention, and education trainings.

735 nights of safe shelter were provided to **105** sexual violence victims.

147 sexual violence hotline calls were answered.
